I. God The Holy Ghost within me guides my thoughts in order for me to think like Jesus Christ in all that I say or do. Read Philippians 2:5. According to Hebrews 8:10 I can locate at least four (4) spiritual actions that happen when God The Holy Ghost guides me.

II. God The Holy Ghost within me guides my worship in order to maximize my personal and public praises that I give to God. I can identify in John 4:24,25 what God The Holy Ghost Father is doing at all times among those that believe like me.
