

With the Sacramento Kings continuing their general manager search, a most-unexpected candidate has been revealed. The candidate is former Kings player and TNT commentator Kenny Smith.

Smith told USA TODAY Sports on Sunday night that he has been in discussions with new owner Vivek Ranadive. Longtime general manager Geoff Petrie has been told that he will not be re-signed after his contract expires later this month, and Smith is clearly hoping to be part of the new regime.
